Agree

- 1. Museums preserve and display our artistic, social, scientific and political heritage. Everyone should have access to such cultural resources as part of active citizenship and because of the educational opportunities they offer to people of every age.

- 2. High visitor numbers are dependent on the excellence of the content and presentation of exhibits. Museums and galleries are usually low priorities when governments distribute funding, hence the collections will be less attractive ad fewer visitors will go even if entrance is free.
- 3. Tourists will pay to see excellent and historic collections of art and artefacts, as evidenced by the visitor numbers at the Louvre and the Egyptian Museums.
